ARRI Pet Food Pantry Low-Cost Kitty Litter Options

1. <u>Pelleted Horse Bedding</u>. It covers up smells just like regular litter and is gentle on your cat's paw pads, less dusty, and easier on the environment. A 40-pound bag can cost as little as \$6. You can find pelleted horse bedding at farm supply stores like Allie's Farm, Feed & Pet, Tractor Supply Company, or any store that sells horse supplies.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Wood pellet fuel is NOT the same thing! Wood pellet fuel is not safe for animal use.

- 2. Chicken Feed
- 3. Alfalfa Pellets
- 4. Ground Whole Wheat
- 5. <u>Shredded newspaper or other paper products</u>. Some people soak and dry the newspaper to make a crumbly mixture. Paper shreds can be used on their own or to supplement litter to make it last longer.

TIPS:

- 1. Add baking powder to any homemade or alternative litters. This will help control odor.
- 2. Scoop every day. This might seem counter-intuitive, but scooping every day will keep the litter fresher for longer, meaning you won't need to throw the whole batch out as often.
- 3. When switching to a new litter, mix it in gradually over a few days and continue to scoop daily.
